Charleston Naval Weapons Station Marrington Plantation Multi-use Trail System

Welcome to the Marrington Plantation Multi-use trail system. This system has been constructed for off-road cyclists, runners and hikers by the Station's Natural Resources office in cooperation with MWR's Outdoor Adventure Center.

Please observe the following regulations:

Users must carry a Department of Defense ID or Marrington Patron Pass issued by the Station's Outdoor Adventure Center. Users under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a sponsor 21 years of age or older.

Stay on the trails and follow the signs. The green blazed Watchable Wildlife Nature Trail is reserved for foot travel.

Cyclists must wear helmets and carry a sound-producing device. Protective gear such as glasses and gloves are recommended.

Off road driving and/or trail use by motorized vehicles is prohibited. Recreational use of ATVs on Station is not authorized.

Equestrians and hikers have the right of way. Cyclists must make their presence known before passing other users. Cyclists meeting equestrians should get off and stand with their bikes between them and the horses while the horses pass.

During deer hunting season (mid Aug to 01 Jan) patrons may not use the trail system during the following time periods:

Mon, Wed and Fri - 1700 to sunset during Daylight Standard Time and 1600 to sunset during Eastern Standard Time.

Sat and Sun - Sunrise to 0900.

Competitions or other organized events are not authorized without express written permission of the Naval Weapons Station Morale, Welfare and Recreation Department and the Natural Resources Office.
